

Getting started with Book Creator for Chrome

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What is it?

Create interactive books with text, images, sounds and video. Save as PDF, video or eBook, publish online. There is an iPad app but this version allows you to create books with a laptop or Chromebook using the Chrome browser. You can also use the Chrome browser on iPads.

How can I use it?

Almost limitless opportunities to make books across the curriculum.

How do I get it?

Sign up at app.bookcreator.com.

Sign up.

Using the Chrome web browser go to app.bookcreator.com and click **Teacher Sign In**. You can sign up with an email or use Google or Office 365 accounts to sign straight in. Children can easily sign in with QR codes and don't need user names or passwords. If your children have Chromebooks they just need to click the Google login option and they will sign straight in.

Setting up QR codes.

If your children have Windows laptops with webcams it's easiest to use QR code logins.

Click your avatar in the top right corner, choose QR logins. You can now type in the children's names or paste them from another source. You'll now be able to print out the QR codes.

How do children join?

They also go to app.bookcreator.com and choose Student Sign in. They then choose QR Code login or Sign in with Google if they are using a Chromebook.

Display Your Invite Code

Teachers now click on **Show Invite Code for Others to Join**. The students simply enter this code.

Children's books will now appear in the library where they can be published, downloaded and printed.
